Last month I told you about the possibility of a space-sharing arrangement with Westwood Church, and why we decided not to pursue that possibility. However, the leaders of Mt. Olive are still exploring how to better serve our community through sharing the truth and love of Jesus Christ with our neighbors. We have lots of space here that doesn't get used very much – could we connect with someone who is looking for space? For example, many churches operate daycares and preschools, and we are looking into that. That could lead to thousands of opportunities to share Jesus with families in our area.

We are trustees of what God has entrusted to us – this includes the buildings and property here at the corner of Bartlett and Wilshire. But most of all, God has entrusted to us the Gospel of salvation by grace through faith in Jesus Christ – and the responsibility to share His Gospel with the world around us! How can we as a congregation do that more intentionally and effectively? We welcome your prayers and input.

Applying Biblical Teachings

There is no such thing as a self-made man or woman. In reality, the amount of money and wealth we receive is a blessing from God. According to his divine knowledge and plan, He blesses each of us with money and wealth for our service to Him. We are given great freedom in the use of these blessings.

King Solomon made this observation, "I have seen something else under the sun: The race is not to the swift or the battle to the strong, nor does food come to the wise or wealth to the brilliant or favor to the learned; but time and chance happen to them all" (Eccl. 9:11).

Man cannot devise a logical course or develop a formula that will insure great wealth. Man stands humbled before God, realizing he is fully dependent on God for the blessings he receives.

This does not mean, however, that we sit idly by praying and studying the Bible, waiting for God's blessings to miraculously appear. The Apostle Paul stated clearly, "... If a man will not work, he shall not eat" (2 Thes. 3:10). In his letter to Titus, he expanded this thought: "Our people must learn to devote themselves to doing what is good, in order that they may provide for daily necessities and not live unproductive lives" (Titus. 3:14).

How should each of us react to our financial state? As Christians, we are led to the realization that God's infinite wisdom far surpasses our limited perspective. In Christ, we accept with a thankful spirit what God has entrusted to us. Through the work of the Holy Spirit, we honor God by our living and by our giving.

At our first quarter meeting on February 18 decisions were made about contributions to charitable causes and we voted to support the following organizations:


- \$212 to LWML Mites
