

YOUR DISTRICT MISSION GIFTS AT WORK: spotlight on University Lutheran Chapel.

University Lutheran Chapel (ULC) is our LCMS campus ministry congregation at the University of Minnesota. One of the first campus ministries established by the Missouri Synod, its mission of reaching and serving students with the Gospel of Christ began in 1925 as a college branch of the Walther League. The ministry has grown and expanded, developing into a ministry served by a full-time campus pastor, then into a student congregation, and then into a regular congregation of the LCMS.

Today the congregation is a vibrant mix of undergraduate students, graduate students, recent graduates and families young and old from all around the Twin Cities metro area. Campus ministry, however, is at the core of its identity, single-minded on the mission to serve the U of M campus and its students with the life-giving Gospel of our Savior.

For the past two years ULC has partnered with the MNS District to support a campus ministry vicar at the chapel. This partnership has helped the congregation extend its outreach on the U of M campus and at other Twin Cities colleges and universities, while giving our future pastors hands-on training in outreach and mission work.

A Message from Pastor Mike

"The Home Altar alters the home for the better"

Where is your Home Altar? Where is the place and time in your daily routine for God's Word? It might be your dining table, your bedside table, or your patio or picture window. It's the place and time where God speaks to you and you speak to Him. You might do this alone, but if possible, it's a far richer experience to do it with others. It might be in the morning or evening, after breakfast or supper, "in-person" or on the phone or internet. For example, Jerry Babb told us recently how he talks on the phone with his elderly aunt and reads the Bible to her.

My goal as your pastor is to help you connect more deeply with the Holy Spirit, who works through the living and active Word of God to make you the person God wants you to be. My desire is that you will give priority to hearing and speaking God's Word, not as another obligation in your already overstuffed schedule, but as a fountain of grace that refreshes and renews you every day.

Every Sunday for the next year we will introduce a weekly Bible Verse, selection from the Catechism, and Hymn. Use these during the week to strengthen your ties to God and other believers. Follow the guidelines in the "Living Planted" document, included with this newsletter. (The weeks of October will be weeks 4, 5, 6, and 7 on the chart inside.) Take a hymnal home from church or get one of your own (more about that soon). Familiarize yourself with all the resources for Daily Prayer on pages 294-330. Invite others to join you. This is not just for parents with children in the home but for all of us, regardless of our living situation.

Let me know what works for you! Where and when is your "Home Altar"? How is God teaching and guiding you? God will bless us as we follow His command: "⁶ And these words that I command you today shall be on your heart. ⁷ You shall teach them diligently to your children and shall talk of them when you sit in your house, and when you walk by the way, and when you lie down, and when you rise."


